






Hwy 65 Ham Lake and Blaine






Hwy 65 Spring Lake Park

Highlight of location needs


- There have been several recent crashes resulting in serious injuries or fatalities involving pedestrians and cyclists at this intersection


Corridor vision







 The city of Minnetonka is considering grade separation at this intersection if this option is not pursued at Vine Hill Rd. to move students to and from the high school





- The city of St. Louis Park notes poor visibility and a high westbound rearend crash rate at Texas Ave







- An upcoming study may be used to further evaluate mobility improvements


