

# 2021-2024 TIP AMENDMENT #9

This TIP amendment was approved by TAB on February 17, 2021, with concurrence from the Metropolitan Council on March 10, 2021.

## Background

This formal amendment is needed to add a new HSIP-funded safety project into the 2021-2024 TIP/STIP for fiscal year 2022.

## Fiscal Constraint

This project was recently awarded Regional Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funding for SFY 2022. Projects from this solicitation will be included in the 2022-2025 TIP/STIP but this project is likely to be let before that STIP is approved by USDOT.

## Consistency with MPO Long-Range Plan

This amendment is consistent with the Metropolitan Council Transportation Policy Plan, adopted by the Metropolitan Council on November 18, 2020 with FHWA/FTA conformity determination established on December 4, 2020.
