
Program 8098 – Hastings Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF)

Description

This program provides funding for planning and implementation of a new Hastings WRRF, located at 2445 Ravenna Trail in Hastings.

Purpose and justification

ES intends to relocate Hastings WRRF service to 2445 Ravenna Trail in Hastings. The new site will allow the plant to expand to meet long-term regulatory and capacity requirements. The long-term service area identified in the 2040 Water Resources Policy Plan may include land areas in the townships of Marshan, Nininger, or Vermillion.




