
Program 809900 – Crow River Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF)

Description

This program provides funding to planning and implementation of a new Crow River WRRF located at 25940 141st Avenue North; Rogers, MN 55374. It will serve the City of Rogers as well as portions of Dayton and Corcoran. ES plans to receive flow at the facility before December 31, 2030.

Purpose and justification

The Crow River WRRF is needed to free up capacity for urban core growth in the Elm Creek interceptor, which currently serves a rapidly expanding portion of Rogers. This facility will serve 2050 projected growth in the communities of Rogers, Dayton, Corcoran, and the surrounding area.
