

Bayport, Brooklyn Park, Eden Prairie, and Mound

LIFT STATION SUSTAINABLE LANDSCAPE RESTORATION PROJECT MAY 2025 UPDATE

OVERVIEW

Metropolitan Council Environmental Services is undertaking sustainable landscape restoration projects at four sites in Bayport, Brooklyn Park, Eden Prairie, and Mound. Work includes replacing high maintenance lawn and invasive plants with native plants and trees that are Minnesota nice – friendly to birds, pollinators, and improving water quality. This project helps fulfill the Met Council's environmental and sustainability goals and guidelines for the region.

All Sites

This year marks the start of the fourth year of the project and the third year of sustainable landscape establishment. Plants will continue to mature and become self-sustaining. The project is scheduled to be complete by the end of 2025, but there will continue to be annual maintenance.

This month, the project team will visit and assess each site to determine maintenance tasks. The team may seed bare spots in the bee lawns and treat garlic mustard weeds prior to these visits.

Eden Prairie

10488 W. Riverview Drive (Blue Lake Siphon)

Due to a change order switching out a small area of bee lawn with a rock island, there will be maintenance occurring around the building.

FUTURE WORK

The Met Council will continue seasonal maintenance work at each location and provide regular updates through the growing season. Check the website for the most recent update.
