Upcoming work

This week, crews continue installing storm sewer, sanitary sewer, and water services as well as replacing maintenance holes within the Riverview Lane site. Crews are installing storm sewer services and replacing maintenance holes within the Mississippi Lane site.

Temporary mailbox changes

For residents who have a temporary mailbox, **new secure temporary mailboxes with locks will be provided in the next few weeks.** This change is being made due to numerous resident concerns regarding the potential for stolen mail.



Next week's update will contain important information about emptying your current temporary mailbox and picking up your new secure temporary mailbox key.

Neighborhood pop-up meetings

Temporary water interruption

Temporary water interruptions continue for residents throughout the project area who have a city connection. Residents impacted by this work were notified with a postcard and will be notified again with a yard sign or door hanger specifying the dates and times of the temporary water shutoff two days before the it begins. **NOTE: Once your temporary water line is installed, please use caution when doing yard work near the pipes to avoid damage to your water line and interrupted water service to your home.**

What to expect

- While we do our best to minimize impacts during construction, some temporary inconveniences such as dust, noise, and vibrations may occur as this work takes place.
- Residents may feel vibrations due to heavy construction equipment in the area. Crews have set up vibration monitors at homes most likely to be impacted. We ask that residents remove any fragile or breakable items from walls or shelves while construction crews are nearby to prevent damage.
- Driveway impacts continue. Crews will contact residents to let them know what hours of the day their driveway will be blocked. Residents will be able to access their driveway each night.
- Waste removal services will continue during construction. Please place your bins at the end of your driveway **by 4 p.m. each Wednesday.**
- Road closures on the Mississippi Lane and Riverview Lane sites will continue throughout the project. Visit the [project website](#) to view road closure maps.
