

Construction activities begin week of April 8

Construction for the Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (MCES) Burnsville Interceptor Improvements project will begin the week of April 8, for Site 2: River Hills Drive. Construction is anticipated to be completed by late May 2019.

Next week, crews will be fusing pipe for the temporary wastewater conveyance system near North River Hills Park and placing it along River Hills Drive, between Cliff Road and Highway 13. **In late April, there will be a 24-hour closure at the intersection of River Hills Drive and Cliff Road to bury the pipe for the temporary wastewater conveyance system.** More information will be sent out prior to this intersection closure.

Upcoming construction activities

Once the temporary wastewater conveyance system is placed, work will begin on rehabilitating select maintenance holes, lining existing pipe (CIPP), and excavating old sewer pipe and replacing it with new pipe.

In late April, a one-week closure of River Hills Drive between Cliff Road and Highway 13 will occur for sewer pipe excavation. More information will be sent out prior to this closure.
