SEWER IMPROVEMENTS UPDATE

Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (ES), operator of the metro area wastewater collection and treatment system, will be completing a sanitary sewer pipe cleaning project in your neighborhood.

Sewer cleaning work has begun

Sewer cleaning work has begun along Main Street between BF Nelson Park and 1st Avenue NE. Cleaning work will occur Monday through Saturday between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m.

This work will be completed in early spring 2025. Restoration of any disturbed areas in the park will occur after cleaning activities are completed.


Cleaning activities include:

- Inspecting pipes using CCTV and sonar equipment to verify debris quantities.
- Removing debris in pipes. Pumps will be set up to keep airflow moving underground while crews are working inside the pipes.
- Hauling dried debris from site in sealed containers for disposal at a landfill.
- Restoring pavement disturbed during the work.

We work hard to minimize impacts, but please expect:

- Small equipment will be used to remove the debris in the sewer pipes.
- Generators to operate the pumps.
- Dust, noise, and sewer odors will likely occur.
- Parking restrictions will occur in the parking lot for BF Nelson Park.
