

MCES East Isles Sewer Improvements Project


Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (MCES), operator of the metro-area wastewater collection and treatment system, is planning to replace and enlarge the aging regional sanitary sewer pipe and structures near Lake of the Isles. To help minimize impacts to area residents, improvements to the existing regional sanitary sewer system will be completed under two separate projects in coordination with the City of Minneapolis' utility work along Humboldt Avenue and the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board's (MPRB) Southwest Service Area Master Plan along The Mall.

2021: Humboldt Avenue (Contract 1)

MCES will be installing two new sewer pipes under Humboldt Avenue between The Mall and 27th Street. The existing sewer pipe that runs under Irving Avenue will be abandoned and removed at a future time.

We will be working with the City of Minneapolis to upgrade their watermain and storm sewer pipes and structures under Humboldt Avenue between The Mall and 28th Street. The City is making improvements to their storm sewer system to increase water flow capacity and to reduce the probability of flooding on Humboldt Avenue.

2022: The Mall (Contract 2)

MCES will be replacing the existing sewer pipes along The Mall between Bde Maka Ska Parkway E and Humboldt Avenue with new and larger pipes. We will be working with the MPRB to replace The Mall road east of Humboldt Avenue with brick pavers as part of the new Woonerf Plaza that will be installed between Humboldt Avenue and Hennepin Avenue (see map on right).



Schedule

The first contract is currently anticipated to begin construction in late summer/early fall 2021 and be completed by December 2021. Final restoration activities may be completed in spring 2022. The second contract is tentatively scheduled to begin in spring 2022 and be completed by December 2022 with final restoration activities completed the following spring.
