### Construction Update – September 2023

Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (MCES) is continuing solids improvements at its Empire Wastewater Treatment Plant in Farmington.

#### PROGRESS UPDATE – 67% Complete

##### COMPLETED/ONGOING WORK

- Building 23 sludge piping, HVAC, and electrical work, Digester #3 cover coating. Buildings 23 and 65 doors and windows installation, brick restoration.

##### UPCOMING WORK

- Sludge piping inside digester 3, Building 23 hot water piping, Existing Digester #3 floating cover removal, Digester #3 Cover installation, hot water yard piping.

##### ANTICIPATED PROJECT COMPLETION

- July 2025
