

Lift Station Fuel Tank Replacement Project

Construction Update: December 14, 2021

Issue 5

Project Overview

Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (MCES), operator of the metro-area wastewater collection and treatment system, replaced diesel fuel tanks at five lift stations in the metro area, including sites in Savage, Plymouth, Orono, Eagan, and Apple Valley. An existing underground fuel tank was removed and replaced with a new above-ground fuel tank at each site. This improvement project was needed to meet MPCA regulations and supply emergency fuel to the lift stations. **Project work began in April 2021 and is now complete.**

Completed work

All construction activities are complete at all five project sites:

- L66 in Savage
- L29 in Plymouth
- L44 in Orono
- L57 in Eagan
- L15 in Apple Valley

Upcoming work

Crews will return in spring 2022 for minor restoration work.
