PROJECT UPDATE #8 - APRIL 11, 2025

Open-cut excavation work is planned to begin in mid-April and continue through this fall. Open-cut excavation (example image to right) is a method for installing underground utilities that involves digging a trench to then place the sewer pipe into. Due to the shallower depth of the sewer, this method will be used in the eastern part of the project.

Tunneling work in the current segment will continue through the end of April.


Impacts

During open-cut excavation work you can expect to see equipment, soil piles, noise, and an increase in vehicle traffic to/from the site. We are actively monitoring noise and vibrations levels and will make every effort to minimize disruptions and reduce impacts on nearby residents and businesses.

Eastbound traffic on Hudson Blvd. N. between Immanuel Ave. N. and Ideal Ave. N. will be closed for pipe installation. Access

to the site will also be through the western boundary of the Oakdale Village Shopping Center. Access to the loading docks will be maintained.
