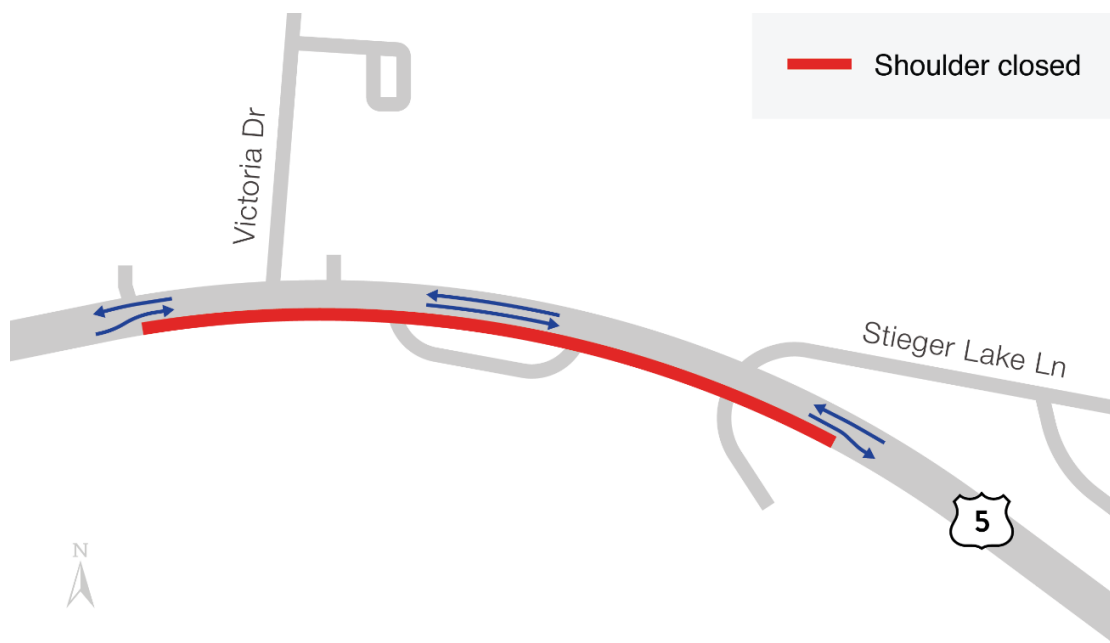


Highway 5 lane shift begins Monday, August 7 in Victoria

Crews have completed installation of the sanitary sewer structures along the south side of Highway 5 and pavement restoration activities will soon begin just west of County Road 11/ Victoria Drive to just east of Stieger Lake Lane. Starting at 9 a.m. Monday, August 7, traffic will be shifted around the work area.



This shift is needed for crews to remove the existing pavement and to pave the shoulder and select driveways in this area. The traffic shift will remain in place until 7 p.m. Thursday, August 10, or until the paving work is completed.

Construction activities and schedules are subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances

Ongoing activities continue in Minnetrista

Crews continue working on underground sewer structures at the lift station located just north of the intersection at Highland Road and Highway 7. Crews also continue working inside structures along Highway 7 between Highland Road and Kings Point Road.
