Minnesota Statute 473.511: Author

Authorizes Met Council to acquire wastewater treatment facilities

Identified intent to request acquisition

2018 Rogers City Council Resolution:

Formally requested acquisition of the Rogers treatment facility



The acquisition of the Rogers wastewater treatment facility has a negligible impact on sewer availability charges **and** municipal wastewater charges.



Wastewater Service to Rogers Area

- The Rogers wastewater treatment facility and the Elm Creek Interceptor will serve Rogers until approximately 2030.
- The Crow River wastewater treatment plant will service Rogers and portions of Dayton and Corcoran post-2030.


