

Roseville Area Regional Sewer Improvements

Construction Update June 1, 2018

Project Description

Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (MCES), operator of the metro-area wastewater collection and treatment system, is making improvements to aging and deteriorating regional sanitary sewer facilities that serve the cities of Roseville and St. Paul in 2018 and 2019.

Project Updates

Dale St. Site – Lane Closures/Shifts

Monday June 4 – Tuesday June 5 there will be temporary daytime lane closures and lane shifts on Dale St. near Eldridge Ave. As construction crews set up the temporary wastewater conveyance pipe, they will bury the pipe where it intersects roads and driveways to avoid long-term traffic impacts. At the end of the project they will remove them and restore the road to its original state.

What to Expect

- It will take 1-2 days to complete
- Dale St. will be reduced to one lane in each direction
- Two way directional traffic will be maintained
- Traffic will not be impacted in the evening or overnight

Avon St. Site – Pre-construction work will begin in mid-late June 2018. This will include surveying the site, and setting up equipment.

Troseth Rd. and Galtier St. Sites - Construction is anticipated to begin in late 2018/early 2019.
