

Lake Street Siphon Inspection and West Meters Odor Control Modifications

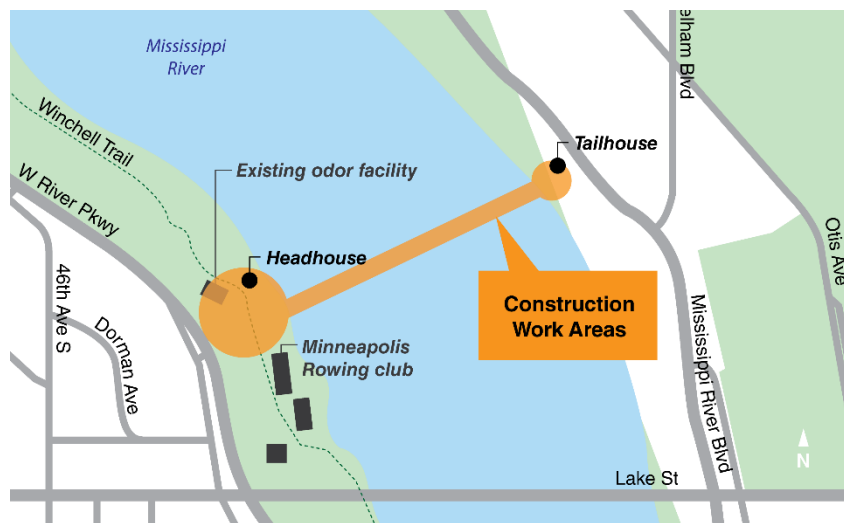


Inspection work has begun at the Lake Street Siphon facility

Crews have started inspecting and cleaning the Lake Street Siphon facility near the Lake Street Bridge to evaluate the current conditions of the facility and determine if repairs are required to ensure future reliability. This work includes inspecting the three 60" diameter pipes under the Mississippi River that connect the headhouse and tailhouse. Inspection work is anticipated to be completed in early spring of this year.

Odor control modifications begin spring 2021

Crews continue to haul materials and equipment on site in preparation for the modifications that will be made to the West Meters Odor Control facility in early spring. This includes making permanent and temporary improvements to odor control measures, sewer structures, and the facilities at the headhouse and tailhouse (see map below).



Anticipated impacts

Work on the West Meters Odor Control facility will require a six-month closure of Winchell Trail and a two-to-three-week closure of Mississippi River Boulevard N between Eustis Street and Pelham Boulevard. Advance notice will be provided prior to the road closure.
