Expect delays on Univ. Ave. in St. Paul due to concrete repairs

Traffic delays are expected on University Avenue in St. Paul beginning the week of April 14 through mid-May as contractor crews repair concrete work at a number of intersections along the Central Corridor LRT Project.

Crews will temporarily close lanes to remove and replace concrete intersection panels where cracks have developed.

Walsh Construction will reconstruct intersection panels at its expense due to contract specifications requiring replacement of faulty work on the Green Line.

Intersections affected by this work include, from west to east:

- Hampden
- Vandalia
- Prior
- Fry
- Snelling
- Pascal
- Griggs
- Lexington
- Grotto
- Dale
- Rice

Crews will work 10 to 12 hours a day Monday through Saturday to complete the work as soon as possible. They do not plan to work on Sundays unless necessary.

Bus stops and sidewalks may be temporarily closed or relocated; follow detours.
