
## Kenilworth Lagoon as a Historic Property

# The Kenilworth Lagoon is a contributing element to the Grand Rounds Historic District.

Grand Rounds is eligible for the National Register of Historic Places under Criteria A and C in the areas of:

- Community Planning & Development
- Entertainment/Recreation
- Landscape Architecture

#### PRIMARY COMPONENTS

- Waterway: the Lagoon and Channel, including the shape of the waterway and its shoreline
- Grounds: the land bordering the waterway, including topography and landscape features

#### **OTHER FEATURES**

- Circulation Networks: Parkways, streets, trails, railroad tracks
- Vegetation: Trees, shrubs, sod
- Buildings and Structures: Bridges, pump house
- Small Scale Elements: Retaining walls, guardrails, benches, streetlights, signage

#### **NON-CONTRIBUTING FEATURES**


- Minneapolis & St. Louis Railway bridges (Park Board Bridge No. 5)
