Vine Species: Boston Ivy

- Attractive in all season
 - dark green dense foliage
 - bright red fall color
 - Appealing branch scaffolds in winter.
- Fast growing, long lives & tough
 - Adaptable to poor soils, dry and moist conditions sun and partial shade
 - Tolerant of and Thrives in Urban Pollution
 - Few if any disease and or pests
 - +20 years







