LRT BUILD is a apprenticeship preparatory program that will prepare you for an exciting and well-paid career in the construction industry. This program offers graduates the opportunity to meet with unions and contractors working on the Southwest Light Rail Transit (METRO Green Line Extension) Project.

Two versions of the program are offered: a 10-week regular program for people who are long-term unemployed, and a 6-week program for high school students who will graduate by June 2017.

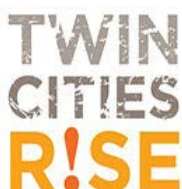
