

# L77 Improvements

# Rehabilitation of the Existing Lift Station

- Improve pumping capacity of existing Lift Station.
- Acquisition of Forcemain along Eastview Road.
- Coordinate with City of Woodbury



## Southwest Lake Elmo Service Extension

## **Improved Service to the City of Lake Elmo**

- New gravity sanitary sewer to City of Lake Elmo
- New crossing under I-94
- Requires large diameter tunneling due to pipe depth and site constraints.
- Coordination with Gold Line and MnDOT.



## Southwest Lake Elmo Service Extension Risks

## **Managing Risks**

- Tunnel construction through silty sand under the water table make conventional pipe jacking unfeasible
- Boulders and nests
   of cobbles in the
   tunnel construction zone
   require more robust
   equipment
- Requires larger diameter tunnel boring machine
- Requires ability to work ahead of tunnel boring machine face



# Metropolitan Counci

## Hastings Wastewater Treatment Plant

### **Expanding Service**

- Move wastewater treatment operations from downtown Hastings to the Council owned property located on Ravenna Trail.
- Modify the Hastings collection system to transport wastewater to the new plant site approximately 2.5 miles down river to the southeast
- Additional design costs for increased complexity of project
