MWWTP Water Systems Renewal & Improvements Phase 1 – Distribution System Renewal Project Rejection of Bid

Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to reject the bid for construction of MWWTP Water Systems Renewal & Improvements Phase 1 – Distribution System Renewal, Project Number 808963, Contract 22P076.

Background

The project provides for construction of the following at the Metropolitan Wastewater Treatment Plant:

- 1. Replace approximately 21,000 lineal feet of service water piping ranging in size from 4 to 16-inches in diameter.
- 2. Replace approximately 39,000 lineal feet of service water tubing and piping ranging in size from 1/2 to 3 inches in diameter.
- 3. Install flushing hydrants, standpipes, and other appurtenances.

One bid was received February 8, 2023, in the amount of \$41,791,700. The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal for this contract was 10%.

MCES proposes to reject the bid and to re-bid this project because the bid was \$18.9 million higher than the engineer's estimate.

Rationale

Rejection of bids exceeding \$10,000,000 requires Council authorization.

Thrive Lens Analysis

This action supports the Thrive outcome of stewardship as the work supports efforts to maintain the region's wastewater treatment system.

Funding

Funds are provided in the Capital Program.
