





Attendance Commitment

Responsibility

3. Serving as a conduit for information by routinely reporting back to their communities or organizations on the activities and discussions of the Committee and bringing information or ideas from their communities to the Committee.

Active Participation

4. Actively participating in Committee discussions by sharing ideas and expertise.

When departments are planning equity-based projects, such as affordable housing initiatives or transportation equity programs, they may seek input from the EAC to enhance the project's equity impact and effectiveness.

During the development of the Regional Development Guide, policy and planning staff engage the EAC to provide insights on how to prioritize equity, inclusivity, and social justice in the planning process.





The importance of the EAC on the Metropolitan Council can be summarized as follows:

- 1. Expert Guidance: The EAC provides expert guidance on equity matters, drawing on their diverse backgrounds, experiences, and knowledge to offer informed recommendations to the Council.
- 2. Community Representation: The EAC serves as a bridge between the Council and the community, representing the voices and interests of marginalized populations and underserved communities in decision-making processes.
- 3. Equity Lens: The EAC applies an equity lens to policy reviews, program evaluations, and budget allocations, ensuring that equity considerations are central to Council activities and priorities.
- 4. Advocacy and Accountability: The EAC advocates for equitable policies, programs, and initiatives, holding the Council accountable for addressing systemic disparities and promoting social justice outcomes.
- 5. Collaboration and Partnerships: The EAC collaborates with Council members, government agencies, and community stakeholders to foster partnerships, build consensus, and drive collective action for equity and inclusivity.

The committee plays a crucial role in advising the Council on policies and initiatives that promote fair and just outcomes for all residents.



Goal Setting for Equity Impact

Establish clear, measurable goals and objectives that focus on advising equity outcomes, addressing disparities, within policies and programs through the committee's advisory role.



Action Planning for Equity Initiatives

Create action plans that outline specific steps, timelines, and responsibilities for advising equity initiatives, programs, and policy recommendations within the EAC's advisory role.



Monitoring and Evaluation

Implement monitoring and evaluation methods to track progress and assess the effectiveness of equity advisory efforts within the Metropolitan Council.
