



Update: Civil Construction Challenges

- Corridor Protection Wall
 - Required per BNSF agreement
 - Required environmental clearance which was completed after civil construction contracting
 - Added to the Civil Construction Contract by change order
- Secant Wall
 - Unforeseen soil conditions (settling during initial tunnel construction) necessitated an alternative construction method
 - Adding to the Civil Construction Contract by change order
- These issues impact other
 SWLRT contracts and the project schedule





Update: Construction Challenges

- Both of these elements are major projects by themselves; when taken together, they have a significant impact to the project's overall schedule due to their scope and complexity
- Next steps:
 - Corridor Protection Wall
 - Complete change order process: Done
 - Secant Wall
 - Complete change order process
 - Reach agreement on tunnel construction re-sequencing
 - Complete change order process for re-sequencing
 - Update project schedule
 - Reach agreement on schedule

















- Civil Construction Total: 1,167,079 hrs



Monthly Civil Workforce Participation*



Monthly Civil Workforce Participation*


- Total POCI hours to date: 253,423 hrs

- Franklin O&M Construction Total: 46,628 hrs




