WASTEWATER PLANNING AND SERVICE CONSIDERATIONS WHITE PAPER

Anna Bessel and Emily Steinweg provided an overview of the Wastewater Planning and Service Considerations White Paper. The focus was on the six Crucial Concerns identified in the paper:

- Acquisition or rural wastewater treatment plants
- Centralized vs. decentralized wastewater planning
- Inflow and infiltration
- Vactor & liquid waste receiving
- Contaminants of regulatory concern
- Wastewater surveillance

Participants were asked to share their opinions of the relative importance of each of the strategies and actions presented in each White Paper via Mural ahead of the meeting. Discussion was centered on areas where there was the greatest divergence of opinions.

WATER AND CLIMATE WHITE PAPER

Jen Kostrzewski provided an overview of the Water and Climate White Paper. Jen noted that there are not statutes directing how to address climate. There may be an opportunity for the Met Council to be a leader in this area.
