2020 Construction Highlights

- Under construction:
 - 8 LRT stations out of 16
 - 23 bridges out of 29
 - 5 tunnels out of 8
 - 91 retaining walls out of 127
- 94% of private utilities completed
- 65% of public utilities completed
- Completed all 15 building demolitions
- Systems contractor mobilized
- Franklin OMF modifications begin


Civil DBE Participation as of Oct. 31, 2020


Systems DBE Participation as of Oct. 31, 2020





- Civil Construction Total: 866,224 hrs



Total Women hours to date: 73,078 hrs



Total POCI hours to date: 183,809 hrs






Civil Workforce Participation Disaggregated Percentages





 - Kick-Off meeting with Meyer: Postponed to December





Franklin O&M Contract Workforce

- Plan to meet the workforce goal
 - Scheduled monthly GFE meetings with Joseph Serr at MDHR
 - Next Meeting scheduled Dec. 10 to review previous workforce reports, GFE and upcoming activities
 - Working with major Subcontractor partners to identify opportunities to increase POCI and Woman participation
 - Kick-off meeting with Red Cedar Erectors, they staffed Breana Henry (minority/female iron worker) to the Franklin O&M project. Building Strong Communities will be featuring her in a recruitment video.
 - LS Black has monthly conversations with North Central States Regional Council of Carpenters and Metropolitan Local 563 to identify POCI hiring opportunities
 - LS Black has scheduled a meeting with Summit Academy after the holidays to identify additional POCI hiring opportunities




• Metropolitan Council Chair Charlie Zelle was sworn in on January 8, 2020.





DBE and Workforce Highlights:


- Met Council co-facilitated a DBE Certification Workshop with MBE Inc.

- LMJV hold the second Annual Apprenticeship and Career Fair at Humboldt High School.





DBE and Workforce Highlights:

- Project office staff have effectively transitioned to working remotely due to COVID-19.
- LMJV was at 7.74% workforce participation for women and 17.61% workforce participation for people of color.









- To adapt to COVID-19, staff working on all projects continue to work remotely through video conferencing and field staff continue to work in the field.
- Building Strong Communities had a strong model laying out the cohort and supporting future apprentices.





- LMJV hosts a virtual job fair on July 29, 2020 to help connect job seekers and recruiters virtually amidst the COVID-19 pandemic.
- cOVID-19 has also affected unemployment with more than 1 in 3 Indigenous, Asian, Black, and Multiracial Minnesotans applying for unemployment insurance benefits since March 2020.

 MDHR conducted 46 interviews.










- Jon O'Phalen's assessment construction into Fall 2020 activities talks about industry trends, COVID-19, and changes in participation demographics.
