






### Investments in BRT boost ridership

### Successes

- Investments leading to ridership returns
  - BRT
  - local route improvements
  - Express routes on 35W south up 7% since construction began
- Ridership grows in corridors with reliable, frequent, fast service
- Light Rail
  - Blue Line Average Weekday ridership of 32,973 is 34% above the 2020 FFGA Levels
  - Green Line Average Weekday Ridership of 44,004 is 7% above the 2030 FFGA Levels



# Challenges

- Events and short-term challenges
  - School closures due to weather Jan-Feb 2019
  - Operator shortages leading to cuts in service levels on local and express bus
- Long-term and Macroeconomic trends
  - increased auto availability, decreased auto costs
  - changing travel behavior, new modes
  - local trends reflect national dynamics
