



OMF Site Selection Process



- SPO developed initial site selection criteria based on DEIS/public comments to identify additional potential OMF sites
 - Site size of 10 to15 acres
 - Good roadway access to site


- Compatible with adjacent land use
- Flat/rectangular site
- Efficient LRT train movements to/from
- SPO identified 18 candidates sites using initial criteria and presented to advisory committees: 3/11 TPAC; 3/27 BAC; 3/28 CAC; 4/3 SWCMC

Cities Provided OMF Site Feedback

- Eden Prairie and Minneapolis provided comments on DEIS in Dec. 2012
- St. Louis Park provided a letter April 3
- Hopkins provided a letter April 22
- Minnetonka provided a letter April 26
- Cities also provided verbal comments on finalist sites



OMF Site Selection Process

- SPO developed expanded list of criteria and narrowed candidate list to 7 sites; presented at April 11 TPAC
- SPO met with cities and discussed the evaluations April 15-18. Feedback included:
 - Additional potential sites identified
 - Compatible adjacent land use

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- Redevelopment/development impacts
- Impacts to adjacent properties
- Minnetonka and Hopkins requested at special April 19 TPAC additional sites be reviewed
- SPO reviewed 2 additional sites and assigned rating of "Very Good"; SPO conducting further analysis and developing concept layouts/3-D images for all 9 sites





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














BAC and CAC Comments on the OMF

- April 24 BAC Meeting Key Themes:
 - General acceptance of candidate sites
 - Interested in moving OMF process forward
- April 25 CAC Meeting Key Themes:
 - Sites 12 and 13 are near environmental justice communities
 - Concerned with neighborhood impacts

OMF Site Selection Process

- SPO holding OMF Open Houses
 - May 13: Eden Prairie
 - May 15: St. Louis Park

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- May 22: Minnetonka/Hopkins
- SPO continues to evaluate top ranked sites May 23 June 7 and holds additional meetings with cities

- SPO presents top 2-3 candidate sites for input to advisory committees:
- 6/13 TPAC; 6/26 BAC; 6/27 CAC; 7/3 SWCMC
- SPO recommends final site based on input and presents to advisory committees
 - 7/11 TPAC; 7/24 BAC; 7/25 CAC; 8/7 SWCMC



OMF Site Selection Process Next Steps

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• SPO seeks approval from Met Council's Transportation Committee and Council in August

- SPO submits municipal consent plans to cities and county in Q3 2013
- Cities and county conduct municipal consent public hearings during Q4 2013
- Cities and county grant municipal consent approval by end of Q4 2013


SWLRT PE Project Elements

- Location of LRT track

- Location/layout of stations and station access
- Location/layout of park and ride facilities
- Location of pedestrian/bike trails impacted by project
- Layout of roadway features:
 - Turn lanes, lane widths, traffic signals
- Location/layout of operation and maintenance facility
- Identification of LRT systems elements
- Location/layout of connecting bus facilities


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


Opus Hill

 - Real-time Properties (4 tenants in 29,320 SF of office space)










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



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
