






Overall Project Funding Required

EDEN PRAIRIE







- Over \$25 million in local (HCRRA) funds expended for studies & property acquisition
- \$5 million received in 2009 State Bonds for PE/FEIS
- \$7 million authorized in 2010 CTIB funds for PE/FEIS;
 - \$12.2 million authorized for 2011
- \$3.15 million authorized in 2010 by HCRRA;
 - \$3.25 million authorized for 2011
