 2022-55 Cleary Lake Regional Park Master Plan Amendment and Land Conversion, Three Rivers Park District (Colin Kelly)

- Authorize its Community Development Division Executive Director to execute all agreements and documents required to complete the purchase of replacement properties.

Council Members discussed housing priorities as the Housing and Redevelopment Authority updates its portfolio with future affordable housing purchases. Council Members expressed interest in continuing to advance the Council's goals of affordable homeownership for first time home buyers and families of color.
