   engineering services in the amount of \$400,000 each to HDR Engineering, Inc. and AE2S. Motion

- 2. 2017-261: Construction Cooperation Agreement with the City of Minnetrista for St. Bonifacius L24 Force Main Project It was moved by Marie McCarthy, seconded by Lona Schreiber, that the Metropolitan Council authorizes its Regional Administrator to negotiate and execute a construction cooperation agreement with the City of Minnetrista for force main construction inclusion in Minnetrista's Lotus Drive roadway improvements in the amount of \$2,000,000. Motion carried.
- 3. 2017-262: Joint Powers Agreements with the City of Mound and Hennepin County It was moved by Cara Letofsky, seconded by Lona Schreiber, that the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to negotiate and execute joint powers agreements with the City of Mound and Hennepin County for acquisition of real property.
