BUSINESS

2013-157 Authorization to Amend 2013 Authorized Capital Program

It was moved by Schreiber, seconded by Wulff, that the Metropolitan Council authorize amending the 2013 Authorized Capital Program (multi-year authorization) and the 2013-2018 Capital Improvement Program by adding \$34,000,000 and \$2,000,000, respectively, for the Burnsville Interceptor Rehabilitation, Project No. 8080, and the Interceptor Rehabilitation Program, Project No. 8090. The MCES 2013 Capital Budget (annual appropriation) will not increase as a result of this amendment. **Motion carried.**

2013-172 Authorization to Acquire Permanent/Temporary Easements and File Condemnation Petitions, Seneca Interceptor System Rehabilitation, Project Number 808000, Resolution 2013-6 It was moved by Melander, seconded by Wulff, that the Metropolitan Council pass Resolution 2013-6 that authorizes acquisition of permanent/temporary easements necessary for the Seneca Interceptor System Rehabilitation. Project 808000: and authorizes Council legal staff to initiate condemnation proceedings for

those parcels staff cannot acquire by negotiation. **Motion carried.**

2013-173 Authorization to Award and Execute a Construction Contract for Metro F&I No. 2, Maintenance Warehouse Building, Empire Digester, and RMF Roof Replacements; MCES Project Nos. 800625 & 805996; Contract No. 13P065

It was moved by Wulff, seconded by Schreiber, that the Metropolitan Council authorizes its Regional Administrator to award and execute construction contract for Metro F&I No. 2, Maintenance Warehouse Building, Empire Digester, and RMF Roof Replacements, Project Numbers 800625 & 805996, Contract 13P065, with B.L. Dalsin for its low responsive bid of \$2,018,726.00. **Motion carried.**
